David Kostka made a motion to approve the January 10, 2005 minutes; it was seconded by Thomas Hennessey and unanimously approved.

LIAISON REPORT

Liaison Thomas Hennessey gave an update on the January 2005 Township Committee Meeting that addressed the new Greenways ordinance and stated it is on the agenda for the February 9, 2005 meeting as well.

PLANNING BOARD

The following Planning Board applications were discussed:



PB614A Brusco B22 L6&7: Applicant is requesting subdivision into three lots. They are seeking variances for minimum frontage and width due to a cul-de-sac. The Commission finds no adverse environmental impact.

OLD BUSINESS

Vincent Domidion reported that the DEP has proposed Shark River as Category 1 and is taking public comments until February 18, 2005 on the matter. David Kostka motioned that the Environmental Commission supports the DEP proposal. It was seconded by Thomas Hennessey and passed by consensus. Vincent Domidion reported that after Shark River has been classified as category 1 the WRA will support a mechanism for permitting necessary public works such as solid waste management land fill cleanup and mosquito prevention.

NEW BUSINESS/ CORRESPONDENCE

Carol Goubeaud submitted copies of water testing results from various streams to the County Planning Board. These results also go to the NJAW Co. Copies of the results were handed over to Mr. Domidion.

Thomas Hennessey motioned to adjourn the meeting at 9:17 pm; it was seconded by Carol Goubeaud and unanimously passed.
