PLANNING BOARD

The following Planning Board Applications were discussed:

PB # 611 Brock Farms: Application was presented at last meeting. Nothing new to report. No comment necessary.

PB #614 Brusco B22 L 6 & 7: Property is located on Montrose Road. The applicant is subdividing two lots into three lots and proposing a road in one of two separate proposed options. The group agreed there was too much impervious cover and



perhaps could recommend a flag lot with no need for the addition of a road. The Commission will provide comment to the Planning Board per discussion.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS/ CORRESPONDENCE

A letter was received from the State DOT regarding a bridge near Yellow Brook off Route 34. They are constructing a gabion mattress to secure the soil surrounding the bridge. No response is necessary.

Vincent Domidion discussed a resolution submitted to the Township Committee petitioning the DEP to designate all streams filling into the Swimming River Reservoir as Category 1 (highest protected waters). It is possible it will be up for discussion at the next Township Meeting, but not confirmed as yet. Mary Massey requested that Mr. Domidion provide copies to the member for their perusal and to determine if it might be something the Commission should endorse.

John Vig made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 pm. It was seconded by David Kosta.
