## **Meeting Minutes April 2, 2007**

### **PLANNING BOARD**

PB637A Furman B33 L7.01. This is an application the Commission has already made comment on. It is going for final review. There are no new environmental concerns.



B48 L36 Colts Neck Animal Clinic This is a repeat application going for final review. There are no new environmental concerns.

John King Custom Homes B11 L3.03 to 3.10 Applicant is going for technical review. The application is not clear. The commission requests more information and reserves right to comment.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

John Vig reported he will be meeting with the Department of Public Works on April 3, 2007 at 2:00 pm to review the Purple Martin Bird house installation. The birdhouses will be installed before the end of the week. There have been no bird sightings.

Vincent Domidion reported the Navesink Swimming River Regional Storm Water Plan Committee met on March 28, 2007. He gave an extensive update on the Regional Storm Water Plan in entirety proposed studies/plans.

### **NEW BUSINESS/ CORRESPONDENCE**

Thomas Hennessey reported we received a letter and supporting documentation from the NJAWC regarding the Water Reclamation Facility for the proposed development Manor Homes Block 22 Lots 11,12,13,14. The documentation was sent to satisfy DEP requirements for submitting Form TWA-1. John Vig took the documentation for review.

A letter was received from the Monmouth County Environmental Commission that introduced the committee, listed members and meeting schedule and their web site.

Sashe Annete mentioned there was an article in the Asbury Park Press on new PNC Banks being "green".

Sashe Annete mentioned she had received materials from the Sierra Clubs Cool Cities organization. She has signed up to be a member of this club and would like to ask the Mayor to endorse and sign up the community. There is a Sierra Club Guide to Local Global Warming Solutions. John Vig wondered if there was an Emergency Management Committee Plan on the Colts Neck website to address any environmental catastrophes. Thomas Hennessey mentioned that the plan had recently been completed and that he would look into it.

Thomas Hennessey received an Environmental Commissioners Handbook from ANJEC, Association of NJ Environmental Commissioners for anyone who was interested. Sashe Anette took the book to review.

Pat Anderson mentioned there was an article in the Asbury Park Press today about a home using wind power in Union Beach that is being sponsored by the Sewerage Authority.

Sashe Anette asked if we were doing anything for Earth Day. Thomas Hennessey mentioned that there was nothing planned, but if she was interested in putting something together, that would be great.

John Vig motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 pm. Vince Domidion seconded the motion that unanimously passed.
