The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Mr. Kostka who read the following statement. “In accordance with the provisions of the Open Public Meeting Act. P.L. 1975, Chapter 231, public notice of this meeting has been provided by publication of an annual notice in the Asbury Park Press and posting of this notice on the bulletin board at Town Hall.”

PLANNING BOARD

Trump National Golf Course application, PB680, Block 46, Lot 1.52, returns with revised plans dated October 30, 2009. Most of the areas involved are in buffer areas or easements. There are wetlands violations that existed at the time Trump purchased the property, and others that have occurred since the new ownership.

Although it technically impossible to trade wetlands, which have state jurisdiction, for easements, which have municipal jurisdiction, Mr. Kostka believes that the N.J.D.E.P is disposed to that transfer as being the easiest way to resolve the issues. Some of the sites in question became buffers only after the property became a golf course, giving credence to the argument for accommodation. Mr. Domidion suggested that the Commission not issue a decision until it becomes clearer what N.J.D.E.P. may decide.
