

TOWNSHIP OF COLTS NECK  
BOARD OF HEALTH  
February 6, 2007 Meeting Minutes

Ms. Sauter called the Colts Neck Board of Health meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and read the following statement: "As Vice Chairman and Presiding Officer of this meeting of the Board of Health, I hereby declare that the notice requirements of the law have been satisfied by prominently posting on the Township bulletin board a notice of this meeting, and that there has been transmitted by regular mail a notice to the Asbury Park Press and that a copy is on file in the Office of the Township Clerk. I further order that this public announcement be placed in the minutes of this meeting."

ROLL CALL INDICATED:

PRESENT: Mesdames Boak, Flood, Iacono and Sauter and Messr and Engle  
ABSENT: Messers Delle Donne and Faistl  
ALSO PRESENT: Messr McBride and Schatzle and Mesdame Leininger

Donna Flood made a motion to approve the January 2, 2007 meeting minutes and this was seconded by Marilyn Boak and unanimously carried. Mr. Schatzle introduced Jarrett Engle as a new Board member. Mr. Engle grew up in town and is a member of the First Aid Squad. The Board gave a warm welcome to Mr. Engle.

Mr. McBride introduced Shereen Naqui, an intern student from Rutgers University, to the Board. Mr. McBride explained that Shereen is studying public health and will be working with him this semester. Sharreen attended the rabies clinic and is in the process of helping with the Health Annex Plan. She is a great help and we are very fortunate to have her.

New Business – Marc Leber, an Engineer from Two River Engineering addressed the Board. Mr. Leber explained he is representing Ms. Furman on Muhlenbrink Road (PB637) who for estate purposes is subdividing her property. There is not a house being proposed at this time, however the soils are suitable to accommodate both a new well and septic. Marilyn Boak made a motion to approve the application and this was seconded by Donna Flood and unanimously carried.

Mr. Leber, from Two River Engineering gave an informal presentation for Vaccaro (PB637). This application has been in front of the Planning Board several times, each time changing substantially, therefore the Board did not want to hear the application until the applicant knew how they were proceeding. Two River Engineering has sent a wastewater management plan to the county for review, but the county wants to know the types of uses that will be in the shopping center. Planning on the highest usage they calculated a restaurant, a bank and the rest mixed retail. They are still seeking approval for an NJPDES permit, but do not anticipate receiving that for quite some time. The Board agreed the applicant should come back next month when they have more definite plans on the building sizes and usage.

Health Officers Report – Mr. McBride stated the Rabies Clinic went well. It was very light, 40 dogs and 13 cats, but very lively.

The meter readings are going well at the new Country Day School. There are approximately 16 – 20 part time student and they used approximately 72 gallons.

Plans are still underway with the county regarding the Pan Flu and they should be finalized soon. The Township was reimbursed for purchases that were made in Phase I (refrigerator and computer). Application has been made for reimbursement of Phase II purchases but we have not heard anything as of yet.

Liaison Report – Mr. Schatzle reported the budget hearing start on Thursday and all are welcome.

Mr. McBride gave a brief presentation to Mr. Schatzle on behalf of the Board of Health members. As a small token of appreciation for all the years of service and dedication to the Board a placque was given to Mr. Schatzle. The Board was extremely happy that Mr. Schatzle was able to stay on as liaison.

A motion to adjourn was made by Marilyn Boak at 8:15 p.m. and seconded by Jarrett Engle and unanimously carried. The next scheduled meeting is April 3, 2007.
