**ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS:**

**Public Hearing on the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan and Stormwater Management Plan Element of the Master Plan**

Mr. Anfuso, Township Planner, explained that this Element of the Master Plan is a result of the Federal Clean Water Act that was adopted in the 1970's. The State of New Jersey requires each municipality to attain certain water quality standards. The Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan and Stormwater Management Plan Element must be adopted by each municipality by April 1, 2005.

Glenn Gerken, Township Engineer, gave an overview of the plan that his office had prepared. The State publishes guidelines that must be followed and include three criteria's – 1.) control flooding and runoff rates, 2.) promote groundwater recharge and 3.) minimize pollutants going into streams. Mr. Gerken explained to the Board that Earle Naval Weapons Station is approximately 25% of Colts Neck and that Colts Neck has no jurisdiction over what they do, therefore they were backed out of the document.

Open to the public. Vince Domidion, Revolutionary Road stated that he read the document and felt that it meets all requirements and will be beneficial to the Township.
