Single Stream Recycling Collection

HOLIDAY COLLECTIONS will be made on the following days (see enclosed schedule)

Zone 1, Tuesday, May 31, 2016

Zone 3, Tuesday, July 5, 2016

Zone 1, Tuesday, September 6, 2016

Zone 4, Friday, November 25, 2016

Memorial Day (collected day after Memorial Day)

Independence Day (collected day after July 4)

Labor Day (collected day after Labor Day)

Thanksgiving (collected day after Thanksgiving)

Curbside collection will be every other week; collection days are **Mondays** and **Thursdays** (with one Friday collection for Zone 4 noted above and in the enclosed schedule).

With **Single Stream Recycling** (fully comingled), **all recyclables** (bottles, cans, plastics, aluminum, newspaper, cardboard, office paper, chipboard, mix, insert, etc.) **should be placed in the same container; sorting and bundling is not required.** Sorting will take place at high-tech recycling facilities.

Styrofoam containers and packing peanuts are NOT recyclable.

Enclosed is the recycling map, including a list of collection dates for each zone. The collection areas are still the same, Zones 1-4.

Your recyclable containers and garbage containers should be **placed curbside on the night before your collection date.** All containers must be removed from the curb the day of collection. Please note only containers size 55 gallon and below may be used. Containers with other trash hauler imprints and plastic bags may not be used for recyclables. If you need recycling container decals, please contact Public Works.

If your trash collection and recycling days are the same, keep the containers separate curbside.


RECYCLING MAP

Recycling Reminders

- **Single Stream Recycling is in effect and all recyclables (co-mingles and paper) should be placed in one container curbside the night before your scheduled pickup.**
- Containers 55 gallon and below may be used for recyclables. Plastic bags may not be used for recyclables.
- Containers with other trash hauler imprints may not be used for recyclables. Call DPW for decals (732-462-7998).

STYROFOAM PRODUCTS AND PACKING PEANUTS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE.

- Acceptable Materials For Single Stream Recycling:

Comingles:

- Plastics – containers labeled #1 through #7. Examples include: soda, water, detergent, shampoo bottles. Does not include plastic toys, plastic bottle caps, unlabeled plastics and plastic bags.
- Glass – Examples include: bottles and jars from food, beverages. Remember to remove caps/lids and rinse the bottles. Does not include light bulbs, glassware, ceramics, and window glass.
- Aluminum/Tin/Steel – Examples include: soda cans, tuna fish cans, etc. Does not include aluminum foil or trays, pie plates or cookware. Metal bottle caps and lids can be recycled.

Paper:

- Corrugated cardboard. (excluding waxed cardboard and cardboard contaminated by direct contact with food such as used pizza boxes, drink cartons).
- Chipboard/Paperboard – Examples include cereal boxes, gift boxes, and soda/beer cartons. Does not include used pizza boxes or paper contaminated by direct contact with food.
- Newspaper/Mixed Paper/Office Paper/Phone Books/Junk Mail/Brown Paper Bags.
