

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Township of Colts Neck, Monmouth County, New Jersey for the FY 2013 Capital Road Improvement Program - Phase I project and opened and read in public at the Colts Neck Municipal Building, 124 Cedar Drive, Colts Neck Township, New Jersey on Tuesday, August 27, 2013 at 10:00 AM prevailing time.

Contract Documents and Plans for the proposed work, prepared by Glenn R. Gerken, P.E., Township Engineer, of the firm of T&M Associates, Consulting and Municipal Engineers, Nine Grand Avenue, Building One, Toms River, New Jersey 08753, are on file in the office of the Engineer and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours.

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the contract documents and plans by the Engineer upon proper notice and payment of a non-refundable charge of Seventy Five Dollars (\$ 75.00) to defray the cost thereof.

Proposals must be made on the Standard Proposal Forms in a manner designated in the contract documents, must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the work on the outside, addressed to the Municipal Clerk and must be accompanied by all items identified in the Contract Documents including, but not limited to, a Statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company holding a Certificate of Authorization to do business in the State of New Jersey and a bid guarantee (Proposal Security) for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid except that the guarantee need not exceed \$20,000.00.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

Bidders are also required to comply with other provisions of Law including, but not limited to, the requirements of:

- N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 (P.L. 1977, c.33, Disclosure of Ownership)
- N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 (P.L. 2004, c. 57, Business Registration)

- N.J.S.A. 34.11-56.48 (Public Works Contractor Registration)
