The Colts Neck Police Department has received approval from the NJ Attorney General's Office to bring Project Medicine Drop to our community.

Project Medicine Drop allows the public to dispose of unused and expired prescription medications safely, securely, and anonymously. The police department maintains custody of the deposited drugs, and disposes of them according to their normal procedures for the custody and destruction of controlled dangerous substances and report the quantity of discarded drugs to the Division of Consumer Affairs on a quarterly basis.

Our stationary drop-box is located in the lobby of Police Headquarters.

Monday – Friday 8am – 4pm

For safety reasons, **we can only accept solid medications such as pills, patches, inhalers, and similar objects.** It should also be noted that this is only for the disposal of legal prescription or over-the-counter medications. Anyone wishing to dispose of any illicit drug, should follow the normal procedure of reporting it to the police.

We cannot accept liquids, medical waste, or syringes. Consumers wishing to dispose of these objects should speak with their doctors or pharmacists to find the safest and best ways to dispose of them.
