

# RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

	<h2>Paper</h2>	<p><b>INCLUDE:</b> Junk mail, newsprint, magazines, printing paper, phone books, softcover books, etc.</p> <p><b>DO NOT INCLUDE:</b> shredded paper, waxed, metallic, grease/food stained cardboard, no hard cover books (donate those instead), food wrappers, paper plates, cups, napkins, paper towels or items from food/hygiene use or newspaper used for pet waste or household projects.</p>
	<h2>Metal Cans</h2>	<p><b>INCLUDE:</b> Aluminum cans, tin cans and bi-metal cans (tin cans with aluminum lids) are all accepted. <b>MUST BE RINSED!</b></p> <p><b>DO NOT INCLUDE:</b> Aluminum foil, plates, trays or cookware or any metal scrap.</p>
	<h2>Cardboard</h2>	<p><b>INCLUDE:</b> Any kind of cardboard shipping box including waffle section between layers. <b>MUST BE FLATTENED!</b></p> <p><b>DO NOT INCLUDE:</b> Cardboard with waxed coating.</p>
	<h2>Plastic</h2>	<p><b>INCLUDE:</b> Items with a numbers 1 or 2 within the recycle triangle on the bottom of the container and with a “pourable” neck smaller than the body</p> <p><b>DO NOT INCLUDE:</b> PLASTIC BAGS, styrofoam, margarine tubs, diaper wipes containers, yogurt cups, clear salad containers, food storage containers.</p>
	<h2>Glass</h2>	<p><b>INCLUDE:</b> Green, brown and clear bottles and jars.</p> <p><b>DO NOT INCLUDE:</b> Caps or lids, ceramics, dishes, glassware, lightbulbs, windows.</p>
