III. Call to order

- i. Our Swift 911 system was acquired by a larger company called RAVE. Our present system will be supported but the new company has many more benefits and promised that there will be no difference in price. Lt. Mayer recommended the new system, but the Chief is reaching out to other departments to see how they like using it. Several ways to reach out to residents were discussed. calls.

Chief Santucci mentioned that our calls come up as Colts Neck Township so they should not be blocked but we will check with Swift 911 about calls being blocked.
